- medication in ziploc labeled bag with instructions



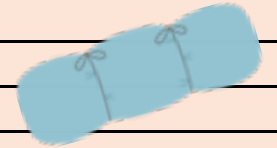
FOOTWEAR

- sturdy shoes



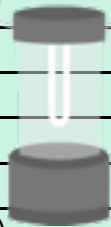
BED AND LINEN
