

## Unicamp Board of Directors Meeting Report

The Unicamp Board of Directors met on May 26, 2021 for a special meeting that was called to discuss children's overnight camp and a proposal for new monthly rental campsites. The board had previously passed a motion to cancel overnight children's camps for the 2021 season due to public health regulations that would have prohibited them. However, new guidelines were released after the decision that allow for overnight children's camps to go-ahead, so long as Unicamp is able to follow all public health regulations. The board rescinded the previous motion to cancel children's overnight camps and passed a new motion, listed below. The board then discussed a proposal for four new campsites, located in the pine forest area, that would be rented out on a monthly basis.

### Motions Passed

**The Board moves to rescind the following motion which was passed at the April 28 special meeting: "The Board moves that Kid's Camp be cancelled due to the anticipated restrictions for over-night camping in Ontario and be replaced by a form of alternative summer programing for children, youth, and adults."**

**The Board moves that if able to meet Covid-19 safety requirements and recommendations, Unicamp will run overnight programming for Kid's and Youth camps (summer 2021). In the event a provincial or local health order restricts overnight camps, Unicamp will shift its programming options and notify all families as soon as possible.**
